The final report is a description of what you learned in the course. It is worth 1% of your grade and due on the date of the final examination (Dec. 14, 10:30 in EIT Auditorium).

Please limit your report to 1 page.

Make sure you spell-check and grammar-check your report.

Your report might consider the following topics:

At the beginning of the semester, you had a sense of what option you were planning to pursue. Did this semester reinforce that concept or change it?

You were given a design exercise in robotics. Engineers frequently design systems. What did you learn about how to design through the robotics sessions? Did the brain-storming exercise help you consider the problem from different perspectives?

Engineers work in teams. What did you learn about working in a team from the team exercises (midterm presentation, robotics)? How could you improve your function in team?
